Text: Zechariah 5:1-11

**I. The Flying Scroll**

**Exodus 20:15** “Thou shall not steal”

**Exodus 20:7** “Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.”

**Galatians 3:10-12** “For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, Cursed *is* every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them.<sup>11</sup> But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, *it is evident*: for, The just shall live by faith.<sup>12</sup> And the law is not of faith: but, The man that doeth them shall live in them.”

**Romans 3:20** “Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law is the knowledge of sin. ”

**Matthew 22:36-40** “Master, which *is* the great commandment in the law?<sup>37</sup> Jesus said unto him, **Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.**<sup>38</sup> This is the first and great commandment.<sup>39</sup> And the second *is* like unto it, **Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.**<sup>40</sup> On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.”

**iii. God's promise to Clean,**

**II Peter 3:10** “But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night;...”

**I Thessalonians 5:2** “For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so cometh as a thief in the night.”

**Jude 14&15** “And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints,<sup>15</sup> To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard *speeches* which ungodly sinners have spoken against him. ”
